



Model Stitched on:
32 count Wichelt Natural Light

Size of fabric needed when stitching on 32 ct. linen/evenweave or 16 ct. Aida is:
7 inches x 9 inches.

Please center and stitch your piece exactly as shown on the pattern, with the backstitched lines as shown and 20 stitches (for linen and evenweave) between top and bottom designs.. (this translates to 10 stitches between top and bottom design for aida users).

PLEASE - DO NOT stitch the box at the end of the bee trail. The box is provided as a guide as where your initials should be placed.

STITCH:

2 strands of floss on all cross stitches and backstitches. Back stitches are to be stitched in DMC 310 for both bee trails and fob outline on both front side of fob (top design) and back side of fob (bottom design).

TUTORIAL:

A free video and written tutorial will follow on how to finish this piece into a scissors fob. This learning piece will be all hand sewn - no sewing machine needed. This will translate into the stitcher being able to finish other small pieces without the use of a sewing machine.
